BRIEF HISTORY OF CHRISTIAN POLICE FELLOWSHIP OF NIGERIA (CPFN)



The Christian Police Fellowship of Nigeria was launched on 3rd March, 2001 at Jericho GRA Ibadan, Oyo State in Nigeria with a fourteen Christian Police Officers in various ranks and their civilian Pastors and friends. This took place at the then resident of AIG (Rtd) Mike Okuo when he was in charge of Oyo State Police command. The gathering took place under a tree which the gathering was named Christian Police Association.

In the power of the Holy Ghost, it brought together other Christian Police Officers who were in various units, states, zones fellowshipping with our Lord Jesus Christ on their own without having prior notice of the one that took place in Ibadan. In the year 2004, the name of the fellowship was changed to Christian Police Fellowship of Nigeria, the reason was that the Police Authority then, saw the name and the behaviour of members as an authority within authority of the Police Force.

Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the fellowship spread like wild fire to all the nooks and crannies of the country, souls were saved, healing took places, miracles and signs of God was all over the stations and various families were delivered from demonic hold. The fellowship built about 68 chapels, these chapels were built through the salaries of members, their offering, tithes and vows, not from the Police Authority or the Government.
